Information on Our Use of Cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies on our website.

Our services use cookies and other technologies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our services.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your device, such as in your browser or on your computer's hard drive.

Some of the cookies we use are essential for the proper functioning of our website. The use of such files does not require your consent.

Types of Cookies Used

Depending on their duration, cookies are divided into:

Session cookies. These are only stored on your computer during your web session and are automatically deleted when you close your browser. These are temporary cookies that are destroyed when you close your browser.

Persistent cookies. A persistent cookie is stored as a file on your computer and remains there when you close your web browser. The website that created the cookie can read it when you visit that website again.

Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the website to function. Strictly necessary cookies, the installation and storage of which do not require your consent, include:

- Session cookies used to maintain the session (i.e., user input cookies);
- Authentication cookies used for services that require authentication during the session;
- User centric security cookies.

Cookies are also used to improve the quality of the website's operation.

Analytical/Performance cookies. These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to the website and to see how visitors move around it when they are using it. This helps us improve the way our website works. The use of these cookies requires your consent.

Marketing and targeting cookies. We may use cookies with our trusted partners for marketing purposes, including to provide behavioural advertising. For this purpose, we store information or access information already stored on your telecommunications device (computer, phone, tablet, etc.). The use of cookies and personal data collected through them for marketing purposes, particularly for promoting third-party goods and services, requires

your consent. This consent may be withdrawn at any time without affecting the lawfulness of data processing before the withdrawal. You can withdraw your consent by deleting cookies from your browser.

In particular, we cooperate with Google and Meta (Facebook), and as part of this cooperation, we use cookies provided by our partners for analytical, statistical, and marketing purposes.

Blocking/Withdrawing Consent

You can change your preferences at any time.

You can also block cookies by activating the settings in your browser that allow you to reject all or some cookies.

However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies), you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.
